Re: Trauma-Informed Training Initiative

Dear Mr. Thomson:

At its November 6, 2019 meeting, the Ethics Board (the "Board") approved your Application dated October 2, 2019 to solicit sponsors in support of a Trauma-Informed Training Initiative. This approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. *In general.* The campaign must be conducted in accordance with the standards, terms, and conditions set forth in Board Regulation 06.26.1 and your Application.
2. *Reports.*
 - i. A Final Report (due within 30 days after all solicitations and receipt of all anticipated donations) must be filed with the Ethics Board on Ethics Form 627.
 - ii. Based on your application's stated aggregated value of donations being sought {"\$500,000 or more"} and other factors, an Interim Report will be due once every 3 months from November 1, 2019.
3. *Expiration.* This approval expires on November 1, 2020, as indicated on your Application. After that date, a new Application will be required for any further solicitation efforts. **NOTE: A new Application for additional solicitation efforts cannot be considered complete and cannot be approved unless all Reports then due under this approval have been completed and filed with the Ethics Board.**
